




What is an Aum mentor NOT?

Profile of an Aum Student

- Single parent family
- Guardian or extended family member household
- Under resourced
- May or may not have transportation. If they do have, it may not be reliable and consistently accessible.
- Student may or may not have a reliable cell phone.
- Student typically works part time and contributes to household expenses.
- Have not had many stable relationships.
- Typically always HUNGRY!!!!



How to build a Genuine Relationship

- Be true to your words
- Communicate effectively
- Build trust gradually
- Make decisions carefully: Don't over commit
- Be consistent
- Participate openly
- Help people


- Be honest: Lies diminish trust
- Show your feelings
- Avoid self-promotion
- Do what you think is right: Values
- Admit mistakes
- 5 to 1 rule





Relationship Barriers

- Narrow, specific goals aimed at changing the girl's behavior
- Inconsistent meetings
- Imposing values
- Setting tasks
- Adopting a parental or authoritative role
- Emphasizing behavior changes over developing mutual trust and respect






Mentor Goals

Trust	Work on establishing a relationship of trust.		
Elevate	Help mentee create a positive self image.		
Help	Help mentee with communication skills. E.g. for written, help them compose a thank you letter, help them begin and end an email. Help them create an elevator speech about themselves, and then practice with you.		
Assist	Assist with identifying scholarships and applying for them.		
Re-Affirm	Assist with planning for financing their education. Follow through with post class activities.		







Celebrate Differences

One of the biggest challenges we experience in relationships is that we are all different.

We have an expectation that people will think like we do.

If we acknowledge and celebrate differences, it is so much easier to create a rapport.

We feel more comfortable when we feel that people "get" us and can see our point of view.



Be an Active Listener

Listening effectively boosts self esteem.

The ability to provide constructive feedback to others helps them to tap into their personal potential and can help to forge positive and mutually beneficial relationships.






Develop Empathy

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Social Media:

- Use discretion with all social media
- Do not post anything that would reflect poorly on you, your mentee, or the program

Be aware:

- A report is required when the child is **known or suspected** to be a victim of child abuse or neglect by persons responsible for the child. Alabama Code 26-14-7.2
- Ensure mentee knows you will have to report any sexual abuse disclosed to you.
- No requirement to report illegal activity.





MENTOR FAQS

Do we have to meet every week?

- If you are a PATHWAY 2 SUCCESS MENTOR, it is a requirement that you connect with your student for at least 1 hour a week.

 - Pathway 2 Opportunity: Bi-Weekly for at least 1 hour
 Pathway 2 Empowerment: Monthly for at least 1 hour

Do we have assignments?

• No. The goal is to develop a relationship.

Can I give gifts?

Nothing over \$25.

Do I have to meet her parents?

• That is up to you. We explain the program in-length to the parents before the girls enter.

- What if my mentee drops out OR requests a new mentor?
 First things first, IT'S NOT YOUR FAULT. We will handle those situations and either assign you a new mentee or you may act in a volunteer capacity until the next year.


